INSTRUCTIONS:

1. To be eligible for awards from the Virginia Breeders Fund, a stallion owner/lessee must submit an Official Stallion Registration Application to the Virginia Thoroughbred Association prior to the commencement of the breeding season but no later than January 31 of the year in which it will be siring Virginia-bred horses, or within thirty days of the stallion's entry into stud in Virginia if such entry is after the breeding season commences.
2. A NOTORIZED COPY OF THE STALLION'S JOCKEY CLUB REGISTRATION PAPERS, clearly showing the front and transfer side of the document, MUST ACCOMPANY THIS APPLICATION.
3. If the stallion is held under a lease or syndicate agreement, A COPY OF THE LEASE OR SYNDICATE AGREEMENT MUST ACCOMPANY THIS APPLICATION and the lease or agreement MUST include a statement that the lessee or syndicate manager is authorized to sign the Service Certificate and to receive stallion awards.
4. REGISTRATION FEE OF \$100 MUST ACCOMPANY THIS APPLICATION. (LATE REGISTRATION: Stallions may register after February 1, but prior to August 31, for a Late Registration Fee of \$250.)
5. At the end of the breeding season, a copy of The Jockey Club list of mares bred MUST be submitted to the Virginia Thoroughbred Association.
6. STALLIONS MUST BE REGISTERED ANNUALLY WITH THE VIRGINIA BREEDERS FUND.
